Mill Town Music Hall Celebrates its 100th Show by Hosting Grammy-Award Winner Diamond Rio

Venue to celebrate milestone performance on October 6

BREMEN, GA. (August 15, 2016) – Mill Town Music Hall is pleased to announce that Grammy-Award Winning Diamond Rio will perform on Thursday, October 6 at 7:30 pm EST for the venue's 100^{th} show. Diamond Rio will sing songs from their newest album, *I Made It*, along with top hits *Meet in the Middle* and *One More Day*. Opening the concert will be returning singer and songwriter, Brent Rupard. Mill Town Music Hall focuses on wholesome, family-friendly music and events and is located conveniently off I-20 in Bremen (1031 Alabama Avenue).

"I am so proud and humbled that Mill Town Music Hall is hosting its 100th performance," said Randall Redding, co-Founder of Mill Town Music Hall. Founded in 1982, Diamond Rio began as a bluegrass music band at a Nashville theme park. The band is best known for their eclectic hybrid of modern country, traditional bluegrass and a hint of rock & roll. Their self-titled album became a platinum-selling smash. The lead single, *Meet in the Middle*, topped the charts, making them the first country group to have a debut single hit No. 1 on the Billboard Hot Country Songs chart. In 2011, they received their first Grammy for Best Southern Country or Bluegrass Gospel Album. The band released a concert album in 2014, and in 2015 released *I Made It*, their first studio album in six years. Diamond Rio has recorded nine studio albums, four Greatest Hits compilations, and a Christmas album. They have also received four CMA Group of the Year awards and two Top Vocal Group awards from the Academy of Country Music.

Tickets for Diamond Rio are \$40 for "premium reserved" and \$35 for "reserved" in advance.
